SAVE OUR LIBRARY

A call to arms, or at least to pen, paper, telephone or email

There are a number of disturbing rumours about the Library in Bury. What I have heard is that although it is to be refurbished shortly, the intention is to downgrade it and have a much smaller facility to enable the council to save money. I have it on good authority that librarians themselves are disturbed by what is proposed for our Central Library. Although this rumour may be unfounded, it seems to be supported by the number of book sales at the library, the most recent last weekend, where tables groan with perfectly sound books, being sold off for tiny amounts of money.

Also, Bury has as we know, a considerable number of empty shop premises, but it seems that the library is to be located during refurbishment at West Suffolk House, Western Way. Not only will people no longer be able to include a visit to the library with their weekly shopping trip but it will be considerably more difficult to get to, particularly for parents with young children and the elderly. It is likely that people will simply get out of the habit of visiting the library.

The demise of the book has long been predicted, and maybe one day it will indeed be dead, but that day is a long way off.
