Rural Initiatives Grant Scheme. (RIGS) The following allocations have been made so far for 2016/2017:

The remaining RIGS balance stands at £52,370.56.

West Suffolk Waste Hub. Negotiations continue with the land owner and SCC Highways about use of the access road and the provision of sustainable transport routes to and from the site. Traffic surveys are being organised once the Sugar Beet Campaign is underway. An application for Planning consent is expected later this year.

Devolution. This week the Leaders of the Participating Authorities in the Norfolk/Suffolk Devolution will consider the results of the extensive and robust consultation and agree the Summary of the Consultation to be fed to the Secretary of State in line with the statutory process. .
