- UPDATE ON CRIME DATA

Crime data is for August 2016. This is to ensure that all crimes during a month are captured accurately. Unfortunately, not all crimes will be reported and counted by the time our newsletter is published (7th of each month) and so this delay ensures that the data received is correct and a true reflection of what has taken place. We will mention any more recent crime series within the further information area if appropriate.

- The 4 x Dwelling Burglaries took place in, Haverhill South x 1 / Haverhill West x 1 / Wickhambrook x 1 / Withersfield x 1. There is no set pattern to the offence's and they took place on four different days throughout August.
- The drug trafficking figure remains at zero for this month. Updates on our significant drug enforcement have been shown in the 'You said, we did' section of the newsletter and this will continue. The reason for the 'zero' records is due to the category of offence's that have been recorded for our work do not come under the drug trafficking list.
- Violence with injury does include any offence's recorded within Highpoint prison. Prisons do create demand for the Policing area in which they are located.
- We would just like to reassure you that each day, an operational meeting is held by Suffolk Constabulary to discuss crimes and incidents that have taken place during the previous 24 hours. This meeting is led by a senior officer. If anything is identified that may lead to an immediate risk to the community, a notification would be circulated at that time to those affected. We would not wait until the newsletter to share such information.
