Responding to issues in your community

Welcome to the updated version of our monthly newsletter. Following feedback on the previous document, it was agreed that a change was needed. The general feeling was that our crime data was confusing and contained insufficient detail to be of use. As an organisation, we are moving away from counting of individual crimes and are instead monitoring exceptions to annual trends. This includes both increases and reductions in crime types and ensures that our response to crime trend is measured and proportionate rather than a 'knee jerk' reaction. Speeding is one of the Force's 'Fatal Four' offences which makes you more likely to be killed or seriously injured. Therefore local officers have been working alongside the Camera safety van, and residents will have seen officers conducting speed checks in Coupals Rd, Bumstead Rd and in Cavendish village to name a few. A number of Traffic Offence Reports were issued.
