5.4 Trees at brook Green

Following the last meeting the clerk raised the issue of boundary conventions (damaged tree which straddling a third party garden and the green) with SALC. SALC responded as follows:

Boundary issues can be challenging especially when determining extent. We are not aware of a convention in terms of maintenance like the example you have given. Often these are lines on site plans/Land Registry title plans or, in this case, the plan of the registered village green. An attempt could be made to establish the extent of the boundary which might be possible to get from the Commons Registration Authority (Suffolk CC). However there is no guarantee they will have this - although they might have older plans which have a clearer line than that on the registered map.

The SALC response does not move matters on much, unless there is the time and will to approach the Commons Registration Authority; I am not sure that they are likely to have any clearer plans than we have available to us now; data from the map would then need to be interpreted in relation to identifiable physical features on the ground as it is now which will not necessarily be straightforward. It may remain difficult to get to the bottom of who is legally responsible for any particular tree.

If the tree is causing a risk to members of the public/ property then in the clerk's view the Council should take steps to ensure risk is mitigated by encouraging others to address the issue/ addressing the issue itself.

The Council previously discussed the possibility of an agreement to contribute to the cost/ split costs which seems pragmatic.
